### FIRST AID TREATMENT

Contains Methyl ethyl ketone, n-Hexane, Petroleum distillates, Toluene and Cyclohexane. If swallowed, call a Poison Control Centre or doctor immediately. Do not induce vomiting. If in eyes, rinse with water for at least 15 minutes. If on skin, rinse well with water.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Wipe vinyl plastic surface to be repaired with clean cloth.
- 2. For rubber repairs only roughen damaged area with metal buffer, then wipe surface with clean cloth.
- 3. Apply cement. Spread evenly over an area 50% larger than patch to be applied. Let dry 1 minute.
- 4. Use ready cut bevels for small repairs. For larger holes or tears, cut piece of patching material large enough to overlap injury ½" to 1". for best ressults round corners.
- 5. Remove protective material from patch by tearing down the middle, remove half at a time. Do not touch adhesive surface. Center patch over injury and press down firmly with thumbs or edge of coin to drive out trapped air.
- 6. For best results LET SET FOR 20 MINUTES BEFORE USE.
